#### Sponsor Letters/Requirements

The following is required by Canon Law to be a Catholic Godparent/Sponsor for **Baptism** Confirmation. Be at least 16 years of age. Have completed the Sacraments of Initiation. (Baptism, Eucharist & Confirmation). If married, have a marriage that is canonically valid and recognized by the Catholic Church. Be a registered and active parishioner living a life of faith. You must be registered with our parish for at least 3 months before we will provide a sponsor letter. Although you may have registered with our parish, if you are not attending Mass regularly and using the envelope system there is no way for the parish office to confirm regular Mass attendance. Please contact the Parish Office to confirm your status with our parish.

#### Did You Know Jesus is the Bridegroom?

"In the Gospel of John, Jesus performs his first sign at the wedding feast of Cana (2:1-11). Jesus shows himself as the Bridegroom who celebrates a wedding with his Bride, the Church. The fact that Mary is there and plays a much more important role than Jesus' disciples underlines, according to Saint John's symbolism, the feminine character of the Church. Cana is at the same time a sign of Jesus' wedding with the Church and of the Eucharist. (The best wine is his blood poured out for us.) Cana shows that the Eucharist has something to do with marital love. Saint John writes, "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him" (John 6:56), This text, which is so important for the Eucharist, reminds us of the statement of marriage in the Book of Genesis: "Therefore a man leaves his father and his mother and clings to his wife, ad they become one flesh." (Genesis 2:24). The physical union of flesh is an image, and extremely weak one, of the total union that Jesus brings about in the Eucharist with his Church and every individual believer... The Eucharist shows clearly that the Church is the Bride of Christ and that he is her Bridegroom He gives his body to her." Stinissen, O.C.D., Wilfred. Bread That Is Broken.
