Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism is ordinarily celebrated the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month at 12:00 pm. To schedule Baptism, please call the Parish Office, at least one month in advance.

Sponsor Letters/Requirements

The following is required by Canon Law to be a Catholic Godparent/Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation. Be at least 16 years of age. Have completed the Sacraments of Initiation. (Baptism, Eucharist & Confirmation). If married, have a marriage that is canonically valid and recognized by the Catholic Church. Be a registered and active parishioner living a life of faith. You must be registered with our parish for at least 3 months before we will provide a sponsor letter. Although you may have registered with our parish, if you are not attending Mass regularly and using the envelope system there is no way for the parish office to confirm regular Mass attendance. Please contact the Parish Office to confirm your status with our parish.

Our Family Faith Formation Full Year Program supports each parent/guardian/grandparent's vocation as the first and best teacher of their children in the ways of faith *in a very intentional way* and provides resources for parents to work with their children at home. Requirements:

- A family commitment to work on the home lessons with their children.
- Attendance at all parent/student monthly sessions (7 Sessions September-March) as there are no makeup sessions.
- Monthly sessions will meet once a month on a Tuesday from 5:30 - 6:30 PM. Please see the calendar for specific dates.
- Weekly attendance at Mass.
- 14 Homily Reflections with raised seal.

Homily Reflection Books

Homily Reflections: Each student must write 14 Homily Reflections as follows: A minimum of 9 Masses throughout the year as well as 3 Mandatory Masses together with Christmas and Easter Masses. (*Minimum Total of 14 Homily Reflections.*) This is not saying you only have to attend Mass 14 times a year. Sundays are a Holy Day of Obligation and Practicing Catholics are required to attend weekly Mass and all Holy Days.



The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which adults who would like to become Catholic, or Catholic adults who would like to receive all of their Sacraments are able to do so. 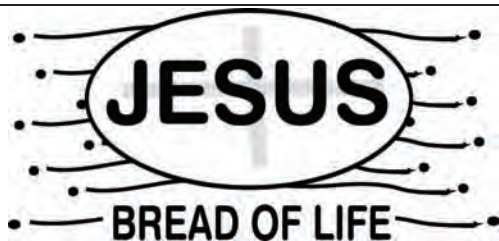

Gospel: John 6:41-51

The Jews were not convinced that Jesus was the bread that came down from heaven. But he again explains that he is the bread of life. He tells them that anyone who believes and eats this bread shall live forever. He explains that the bread he will give is his flesh, for the life of the world.

“Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with which you were sealed for the day of redemption. All bitterness, fury, anger, shouting and reviling must be removed from you, along with all malice. And be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven you in Christ. So be imitators of God, as beloved children, and live in love as Christ loved us...”

Saint Paul causes us to pause and look closely into our hearts. It is so easy to be afflicted by the negative feelings and emotions, which tend to separate us from God and one another.

Instead, as he writes in several letters, be kind, compassionate and forgiving. How often we see the signs of KFC reminding us not of a gourmet dinner, but of these virtues which allow us to be imitators of God, living in love. Paul was teaching the first Christians then, but also teaches us today. Think about it!
